Dispelling Myths with a few Oklahoma firearms laws:

1. The myth of the gun show loophole:
  - a. Every and all licensed dealers must complete a citizenship, mental health, and criminal background check (4473) with the ATF before selling a firearm or they are committing a federal felony.
  - b. No exceptions, in store, out of store, at a gun show, in a parking lot...
  - c. Purchase of firearms with the intent to resale them without a federal firearms license is a federal felony.
2. A private citizen cannot sell their gun to just anyone, it is the sellers responsibility to check on the buyer, not the buyer to inform the seller.
  - a. A private citizen that provides (sells, gives, gifts, through negligence allows to possess) a firearm to a mentally incompetent person is guilty of a felony. (TITLE 21 § 1289.10)
  - b. A private citizen that provides (sells, gives, gifts, through negligence allows to possess) a firearm to a convicted person is guilty of a felony. (TITLE 21 § 1289.12)
  - c. A private citizen that provides (sells, gives, gifts, through negligence allows to possess) a firearm to a minor person is guilty of a felony. (TITLE 21 § 1273)
3. You can carry your firearm into a restaurant or liquor store but you cannot carry it into a bar. The key phrase in the law is “where alcoholic beverages are consumed”. (TITLE 21 § 1272.1)
  - a. You can carry into a restaurant that serves alcohol where the sale of low-point beer or alcoholic beverages does not constitute the primary purpose of the business.
  - b. A bar is any place in which alcohol is consumed and constitutes its primary purpose of the business or earns 51% of its income from alcohol sales and consumption.
  - c. Alcohol cannot be opened or consumed in a liquor store therefore carry is legal there.
4. Any level of intoxication while in possession of a firearm is a illegal. (TITLE 21 § 1289.9)
5. Who cannot have a gun:  
Convicted in any court with imprisonment exceeding one year, fugitive from justice, drug user, mental defective, illegal alien, discharged dishonorably from the Armed Forces, renounced citizenship, under legal restraining order, charged with domestic violence. (TITLE 18 U.S.C. §922)
